CCTV monitoring – GDPR information clause

In accordance with Article 13 para. 1 and para. 2 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (GDPR), we inform that:

- 1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Biblioteka Publiczna w Dzielnicy Ochota m.st. Warszawy with its registered office at ul. Grójecka 77, 02-094 Warsaw
- 2. The data administrator can be contacted via email: iod@bpochota.waw.pl or phone number 22 659-44-56
- 3. CCTV monitoring is used to protect property.
- 4. The legal basis for processing personal data is execution of the legitimate interests of the administrator of personal data (in accordance with Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR)
- 5. CCTV recordings will be kept for the period of 7 days.
- 6. CCTV monitoring covers the library drop box and immediate area.
- 7. The person whose personal data is processed has specific rights under the GDPR. Therefore, you have:
 - right to access your personal data
 - right to data processing for a limited time
 - right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data
- 8. If you believe that the data administrator's processing violates the provisions of the GDPR, you have the right to file a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
